My recent move to Castle Rock puts me one step closer to my commitment of joining staff with Engineering Ministries International by July. Praise God for providing this residence until I move to Colorado Springs at the end of June! James, one of my friends and former coworkers, recently began a job in Lakewood, resulting in him vacating his apartment in Castle Rock. Since his lease had not expired, I am taking his place to be closer to my office in Centennial and eMi's office in Colorado Springs. I plan on taking advantage of my short time based in Castle Rock to visit churches in Colorado Springs and to volunteer weekly at eMi.

Praise God for providing 1/2 of my monthly support! I am extremely grateful to all of you who are investing financially in the ministry God is drawing me into. I am reaching a point of urgency to raise the remaining financial support. EMI requires all staff engineers to raise support because we donate our professional design services to ministries. My cost of living and ministry expenses are funded by donations to eMi. In order to begin full-time by July 1st, I need 90% of my monthly funding pledged. God Restores the Joy of His Salvation

Only God is able to bring true and lasting joy. My recent time in Haiti and the church service I visited at Boulder Street Church in Colorado Springs have reminded me of this. The Spirit has been highlighting several key points to me from that message using Psalm 51.

- God creates in us a new heart (v. 10), showing His creative & repairing power
- God gives the Holy Spirit to be with believers forever (v. 11; Jn 14:16)
- God restores the joy of His salvation and grants us a willing spirit (v. 12)

With new creation, renewal, closeness, joy, and willingness that God puts in us believers, He uses us to teach others His ways and to turn sinners back toward Himself! (v. 13)

Because of my longing to make the Lord known among the nations, I am preparing to leave my job and fully give the rest of my life to exalt Him by loving and serving people around the world. I must remember that I can do nothing apart from Jesus (Jn 15:5). Therefore, I will remain in Jesus, rejoicing in His salvation and obeying Him in the power of His Spirit while He grants me life.

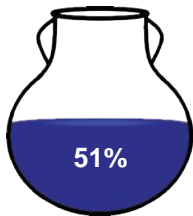
In that day you will say:

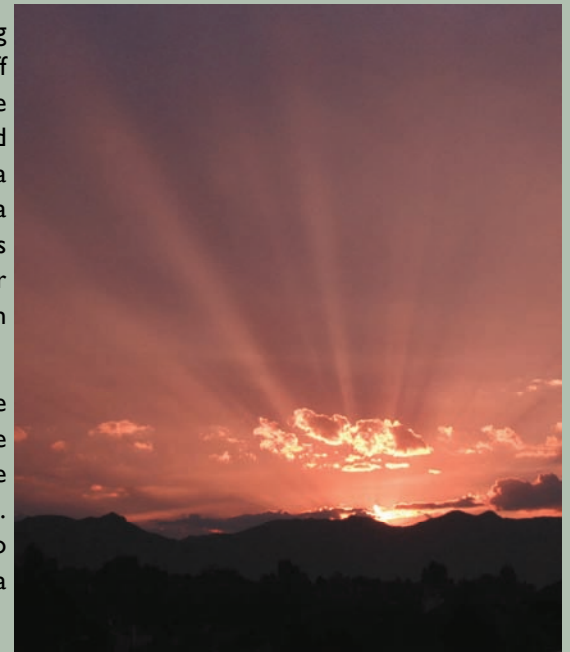
